Patti Anne's Patterns



Kiely's Kardigan





Traditional Toddler Cardigan

This is an adapted version of a design which appears in TKGA Cast On - May-July 2008 by Melissa Leapman

Sizes: 2, (4, 6, 8)

Finished Measurements:

Approximately

Chest: 25 (27, 30, 32)" Length: 14 (14 $\frac{1}{2}$, 15 $\frac{1}{2}$, 16)"

Materials:

Lion Brand Baby Soft (5 oz/140 gm, 459 yds/420 m, 60% acrylic, 40% nylon) 4 (4, 5, 5) skeins #099 Cream #8 (5mm) Needles or needle size required to get gauge $5 - \frac{3}{4}$ " buttons

Gauge: With sz 8 needles & working with yarn doubled in Pebble Stitch Pattern:

18 sts & 24 rows = 4"/10 cm

Always take time to check your gauge.

Stitch Patterns:

Lace Pattern: (mult 6 +1 sts) for borders & collar

Row 1: (RS) * K1, YO, K1, sl next 2 sts knitwise, K1, P2SSO, K1, YO rep from * across ending with a K1.

Row 2: Purl across

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 for pattern

Pebble Stitch: (Mult 4 sts) for sweater body & sleeves

Row 1: (RS) *K2, P2 rep from * across

Row 2: Purl across

Row 3: *P2, K2, rep from * across

Row 4: Purl across

Repeat Rows 1 thru 4 for pattern

Garter Stitch: Knit every row.

Back

CO 55 (61, 67, 73) sts and work in Lace Pattern for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", ending with a WS row.

For sizes 2& 6: Knit 3 rows, increasing 1 st at the end of the last row - (56, 68) sts.

For size 4 & 8: Knit 3 rows, decreasing 1 st at the end of the last row - (60, 72) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Then change to Pebble Stitch Pattern, and work even until piece measures $7\frac{1}{2}$ ($7\frac{1}{2}$, 8, 8)" from the beg, ending with a WS row.

Armholes: BO 4 (4, 5, 5) sts at the beg of the next 2 rows.

Continue even in Pebble Stitch until piece measures 13 (13 $\frac{1}{2}$, 14 $\frac{1}{2}$, 15)" from the beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders: For size 2: BO 4 sts at the beg of the next 6 rows. 24 sts rem. BO.

For sizes 4 (6, 8): BO 5 (6, 7) sts at the beg of the next 4 rows, then BO 4 (5, 5) sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. BO rem 24 sts.

Left Front

CO 25 (31, 37, 37) sts. Work in Lace Pattern for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", ending with a WS row.

For sizes 2: Knit 3 rows, increasing 3 sts evenly across the last row. - 28 sts

For size 4 & 8: Knit 3 rows, decreasing 1 st evenly at the end of the last row. - 30 (36) sts.

For sizes 6: Knit 3 rows, decreasing 3 sts evenly across the last row. - 34 sts

Purl 1 row.

Then change to Pebble Stitch Pattern, and work even until piece measures $7\frac{1}{2}$ ($7\frac{1}{2}$, 8, 8)" from the beg, ending with a WS row.

Note: For szs 2 & 8 work Pebble Stitch Pattern as shown above.

For szs 4 & 6 work as follows:

Row 1: K1, *K2, P2, rep from * across, ending K1

Row 2: Purl across

Row 3: P1, * P2, K2, rep from * across, ending P1

Repeat Rows 1 thru 4 for pattern

Armhole: BO 4 (4, 5, 5) sts at the beg of the next row.

Continue even in Pebble Stitch Pattern as established until piece measures $11 \frac{1}{2}$ (12, 13, $13 \frac{1}{2}$)" from the beg, ending with a RS row.

Neck: BO 4 sts at neck edge once, BO 2 sts at neck edge once, then dec 1 st at neck edge every row 6 times. 12 (14, 17, 19) sts.

Continue even in Pebble Stitch until piece measures 13 (13 $\frac{1}{2}$, 14 $\frac{1}{2}$, 15)" from the beg, ending with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders: For size 2: BO 4 sts at the shoulder edge, 3 times.

For sizes 4 (6, 8): BO 5 (6, 7) sts at the shoulder edge 2 twice, then BO 4 (5, 5) sts at the shoulder edge once.

Right Front

Same as Left Front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves (make 2)

CO 31 (31, 37, 37) sts. Work in Lace Border Pattern for $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", ending with a WS row.

Knit 3 rows, increasing 1 st at the end of the last row. 32 (32, 38, 38) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Then change to Pebble Stitch Pattern, and inc 1 st each end every 1", 9 (10, 11, 12) times. 50 (52, 60, 62) sts

Work even until piece measures 13 (13 $\frac{1}{2}$, 14, 14 $\frac{1}{2}$)" from the beg. BO.

Finishing

Button Band: With RS facing and <u>single strand of yarn</u>, pick up 62 (64, 66, 68) sts along the left front edge. Then cast on 5 sts more. (To cast on sts: *Knit 1, leaving stitch on left needle. Transfer new stitch onto left needle by slipping it knit-wise. Repeat from * 4 more times)

Working with 2 strands of yarn now & in Garter Stitch:

Row 1: K4 sts, k2 tog (1 st from the provisional cast on and 1 st from the picked up edge sts) Turn work around

Row 2: K5 sts. Turn work around.

Row 3: K4 sts, k2 tog (1 st from the working sts and 1 st from the picked up edge sts) Turn work around.

Row 4: K5 sts. Turn work around.

Repeat these last 2 rows until top edge is reached and last picked up st is worked in. BO 5 sts.

Mark the Button Band for the placement of 5 buttons evenly spaced with the first $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom edge and the last $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top edge. Use this placement as your guide for working the buttonholes into the Buttonhole Band.

Buttonhole Band: With RS facing and <u>single strand of yarn</u>, pick up 62 (64, 66, 68) sts along the right front edge. The provisionally cast on 5 sts more.

Work Buttonhole Band the same as the Button Band, making the buttonholes opposite the markers:

Row 1: K2 sts, BO 2 sts, k2 tog (1 st from the working sts and 1 st from the picked up edge sts) Turn work around.

Row 2: K3 sts, CO 2sts over the BO sts of the previous row, K1. Turn work around.

Complete the same as the Button Band.

Sew shoulder seams.

Collar

With RS facing and $\underline{single\ strand\ of\ yarn}$, beginning and ending halfway into the front bands, pick up and knit 73 (73, 79, 79) sts.

Next row: with 2 strands of yarn, purl across.

Change to Pattern and work even until collar measures 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". BO loosely.

Sew top edge of sleeves to armholes. Sew sleeve and side seams. Sew on buttons.
