

Patti Anne's Patterns

Cotton Bathroom Rug



BEGINNER



Materials: Lily Sugar'n Cream 100% USA Grown Cotton approx. (2) 1 lb. cones

Note: my finished rug weighs in at 25 oz., so if you would like a rug slightly larger be sure to get an extra cone of yarn.

Gauge: About 3 sc & 3 rows = 1"

Finished size: 22" x 36"

Hook: I- 9, 5.50 mm, or larger if you want a looser fabric

Pattern Stitch: Multiple of 12 + 10

Rug is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together

Chain 83 loosely.

Row 1: 1 sc in second chain from hook, sc in each of the next 4ch, ch3, sc in each of the next 5 ch, *skip next 2 ch, sc in each of the next 5 ch, ch3, sc in each of the next 5 ch; repeat from * across = 7 ch3 spaces.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, pull up a loop in each of the first 2 sc, YO, pull thru all 3 loops on hook (1 decrease), sc in each of the next 3 sc, * 1 sc, ch3, 1 sc in next ch 3 space, sc in each of the next 4 sc, skip the next 2 sc, sc in each of the next 4 sc, repeat from * across, end last repeat, 1 sc, ch 3, 1 sc in the next space, sc in each of the next 3 sc, pull up a loop in each of the last 2 sc, YO, pull thru all 3 loops on the hook (1 decrease)

Repeat Row 2 until 36", or desired length.

I made this rug some time ago, and have put it in the washing machine and dryer quite a lot and it has shrunk just a tiny bit, but stills looks great.
