
Patti Anne's Patterns

Donegal Tweed Beret







Materials: One Skein Tahki Donegal Tweed

Gauge: 3.5 sts = 1"

Needles: #10.5 circulars & set of #10.5 DPNs - or needles size required

to get gauge

Pattern Stitch:

Row 1 & 2: *P2, K2 rep from * around Row 3 & 4: *K2, P2 rep from * around

With circular needles cast on 80 sts loosely. Join, being careful not to twist and work in K2, P2 rib for 1".

Change to Pattern stitch and work even until 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the beginning.

Decrease Shaping: changing to DPNs when needed -

Row 1: *K2, K2 tog, repeat from * around (60 sts)

Row 2: Knit around

Row 3: *K1, K2 tog, repeat from * around (40 sts)

Row 4: Knit around

Row 5: K2 tog around (20 sts)

Row 6: Knit around

Row 7: K2 tog around (10 sts)

Row 8: Knit around

Row 9: K2 tog around (5 sts)

Cut yarn 12" long & pull through the last 5 sts to close the top. Pull tightly and weave in end.

Optional: Sew in 2 rows of elastic thread into the first 2 rows of ribbing.
